## Junior Academy Step by Step

# **Step 1 - Scheduling & Planning**

Please find listed below the recommended actions that you need to take during this step of implementation:



#### **Decide on your Program Year**

may need exclude winter or summer periods.

#### **Research the School Term Dates**

Your Junior Academy classes should run to align to the School Term Dates with break weeks during school holidays dates. You should research the school term dates for your area to understand the number of weeks each of your Academy blocks can run for.

#### **Decide on the Junior Academy Ages**

availability and demand at your venue.

### **Decide on the Number of Classes within Each Age Group**

Once you have decided on the age based groups you will be offering, you will need to deice on the number of different classes you will offer each block within each age range.

#### **Price your Junior Academy Blocks**

Decide on the price of your Junior Academy blocks across the program year. The price may vary depending on the number of weeks that can be delivered within each block.



#### **Price your Registration Fee**

We recommend you charge a one off registration fee for your Junior Academy program. This will include each child receiving their Junior Welcome Pack including their MyAcademy Folder to track their progress and White Hat which they can use to collect their Hat Pin Awards.



#### Schedule your Junior Academy Classes Across the Program Year


