




Step 1 - Scheduling and Planning

| | Assess Facility Access |

| | Ensure you assess access to practice facilities at your venue and discuss the program with your management team. Remember you will need access to a driving range, short game area and putting green to be able to run all of the Skills Pathway programs. |
| | Decide on the Skills Pathway Program Type |
| | Decide which of the Skills Pathway programs you are going to offer from the three types, Become a Driving Wizard, Become a Short Game Wizard and Become a Putting Wizard. |
| | Decide on the Program Level Dates |
| | The Skills Pathway Program consists of three skills and three levels for each skill. We recommend you schedule your program a year ahead of time, making sure there are regular starting points throughout the year for each skill and level depending on the Skills Pathway program you decide to run. |
| | Price your Skills Pathway Program |
| | Decide on the price of your Skills Pathway program. You can use our handy calculator within the Skills Pathway page, but you need to consider if your price includes other chargeable elements at your venue. |
| | Schedule your Skills Pathway |
