
Step 2 - Marketing Creation

Compile a Targeted Marketing List

Prepare a targeted marketing list of members/ students at your venue who will be specifically suited to the Skills Pathway program using your current databases. The Skills Pathway Program is designed for all levels of club golfer and therefore should be targeted at all club golfers and potentially even interested dependants, friends or spouses.


