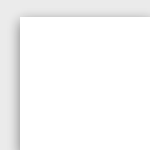

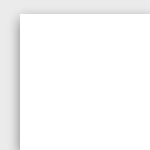

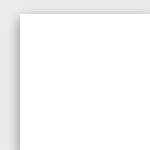
Compile a Targeted Marketing List

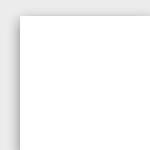
Create your Event Flyers & Posters

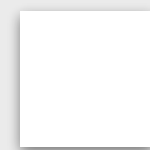
Edit the 'Targeted List' Communication Template

Edit this communication ready to send to your targeted marketing lists. This is available within the Team Matchplay event page.



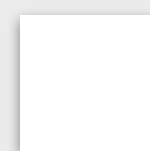
Generate your Event Short Links - Watch Tutorial by [CLICKING HERE](#)
